# An old Jewish tradition based (sort of) on Deut 33:2

(where YHWH comes forth from a thousand "holies", or "holy ones" to give the Law to the people)

# Also because "messenger of YHWH" is who gives Law on Sinai elsewhere

(in Exodus etc.)

#### But "angel of YHWH" still called and treated as YHWH everywhere

## So, distinct person but also YHWH

big problem for Jewish theology

### Some said therefore YHWH wasn't there

(and a huge number of other incidents in OT)

#### after all

(only a delegated representative who could speak <u>and be</u> worshiped as if YHWH)

#### This is still a position among some Jews and 'unitarian' Christians today

Hebraist started off talking about someone distinct from Father but also somehow YHWH

#### The "Son of God"

Namely, Jesus. (2:9)

# God (which includes WHO??

### God DISCIPLINES (which includes PUNISHING) those He intends to be inheritors!

### But, doesn't Heb 3-4 say

#### But, doesn't Heb 3-4 say "They shall NEVER enter into My rest"

### Actually, in Greek, it reads,

## "If they shall be entering into My resting--!"

stop period

### Could be read as hyperbole

(For example, "I'll be danged if they'll be entering into My resting)

But in the NT the phrasing (from Aramaic) is always predictive

### For example John 6:62

"This is snaring you?! [i.e. the flesh munching statements just previously] If then you should be beholding the Son of Man ascending where He was formerly--!"

#### In other words how much moreso or what will you do when this occurs?

## The point is lost if the event does not happen!

If the form is 'Negative, so what if positive?' then negative needs changing

### TO MATCH THE COMING POSITIVE!

# In Greek "judgment" = same word we get "crisis" from.

#### Also, Christ is coming to judge all to render to everyone according to his work (or to His!)

## Both ideas are found in Epistle to Hebrews (also elsewhere, duh)

### But, punishment is intended to lead to

## Repentance Salvation Righteousness

#### all from God

(not originating by works of man)

(<u>but</u> we're expected to cooperate)

## Most pertinent example: (see Deut)

(surprise?)

#### Most pertinent example: (see Deut) Moses! (surprise!)

### But no one doubts Moses will enter into God's rest!

And Moses testifies to salvation of those who die as rebel Israel too.

# With promises as well as threats good for

(a main reason why ortho-trin is important)

## Also because (Heb 4:15-16)

(if two-natures doctrine of ortho-trin is true)

# Also because God goes the distance sympathizing with us

(if two-natures doctrine of ortho-trin is true)
(a main reason why doctrine of two natures of Christ is so important)

# But, didn't \_\_\_\_\_ find no place for his \_\_\_\_\_ and so lost

But, didn't Esau find no place for his repentance and so lost his inheritance?

#### In one way, the inheritance was never Esau's to lose in the first place.

(God had chosen beforehand who would have it: Jacob)

#### And actually, he wasn't because he still his

And actually, he wasn't repenting, hecause he still hated his brother!

(Who, by the way, acted rather Satany to claim his inheritance!

Plenty of blame to go around.)

#### Did Esau hate his brother forever? (And did Jacob get away with acting Satany?)

## Read Genesis and find out!

(spoiler: no. {g})

## Actually, a provision was left in for Esau.

#### Reconcile with his brother and be blessed with his brother's blessing!

That was a major theme in the Synoptics, too.

#### Speaking of archetypal Biblical enemies reconciling...

## REMEMBER THOSE ANGELS?!

#### FROM HEB 1:6?!

(TOLD YOU WE'D BE GETTING BACK TO THEM!)

#### THE HEBRAIST IS QUOTING PSALM 97. WHO ARE THOSE ANGELS?

(surprise! {G!})

#### HOLY CHRIST!!

## GOD REALLY WINS!!!

#### SO, SPEAKING OF THOSE REBELS BECOMING LOYAL AGAIN...

(and in context of idolatry of believing "angels" gave Law)

#### YET IF WE NEGLECT SO GREAT A SALVATION THEN...

(but a lot more can be said on this topic.)
